

Plasma-Lyte Usage and assessment of
kidney Transplant Outcomes in children

Why are we doing this research?

After your kidney transplant, your doctors will give you a special type of water (*doctors call this fluid*). This research study is being done to find out which fluid is best to give to children after their transplant. The fluid is given to help keep your new kidney working.




But sometimes this can make you feel poorly, so we want to try a different fluid which we hope will work better.

Do I have to take part?

No, it is up to you if you want to take part. You can change your mind at any time.

What will happen to me if I take part?

We will ask you and your parents/carers some questions, to make sure you want to take part. You will then have your operation as




We would like to ask you and your family if you want to take part in a research study. A research study is a way that doctors try and find out answers to questions to help people get better.

This information sheet tells you more about the study. You are being asked whether you'd like to take part because you are going to have a kidney transplant operation.

If something doesn't make sense or you have any questions - ask your parents/carers or your doctors who will help you.

normal. After your operation, your doctors will either give you the normal fluid or the different fluid.



The fluid is given using a special plastic line (all children have this after a transplant).

Your doctors will check how you are feeling after your operation and record lots of measurements about how your new kidney is working. We will use these measurements to decide if the normal fluid or new fluid works better.

Will taking part help me?

The study may not help you right now but it will help doctors to make other children better in the future.

What if something goes wrong?

You can talk to your parents/carers and doctors at any time.

Did anyone check that this research is OK to do?

A group of people have checked to make sure this research study is fair.

What will happen at the end of the study?

We will let you know what we have found out. The study will be talked about, but no one will know you have taken part. All of your information, like your name and your birthday, will be kept private.

What if I don't want to take part anymore?

Just tell your parents/carers and doctors. It is up to you and you don't have to tell us why.
